## MOCAP Courseware Accommodations and Modifications

<u>Differentiated Instruction</u> refers to adjustments in teaching methods or materials to accommodate each student's learning needs and preferences and is available for all students. These instructional strategies should not be documented on Form F.

<u>Accommodations</u> are changes in procedures or materials that increase equitable access in the instructional setting. Accommodations generate comparable results for students who need them and allow these students to demonstrate what they know and can do.

<u>Modifications</u> are changes in procedures or materials that change the construct of the educational task making it difficult to compare results with typical peer results. Modifications allow students to demonstrate what they know and can do in a non-standardized way.
