## Boonville R-1 School District - Greenways Virtual Student Expectations

The Boonville R-I School District is not required to provide access to computers, Internet, or other necessary technology resources to students choosing to take a MOCAP course.

The Boonville R-I School District is not required to provide a supervised location for students taking a MOCAP course.

Students must have good computer skills, time-management skills, persistence, and good written communication skills to be successful in an online course.

Students enrolled in MOCAP courses will follow the school calendar and are expected to complete all course requirements by the end of the semester as stated on the Board-approved district calendar.

Students who enroll in MOCAP courses will actively participate in those courses with the goal of completing each course. If a student does not actively participate in a course or is not successful in a course, the district may remove the student from the MOCAP course.

Students will maintain contact with their teacher weekly.

Students will attend live lessons with their teachers.

Students will abide by the Honor Code.

Students will login each school day and complete assigned work on their planner.

Students will participate state-required MAP grade level and EOC examinations administered by the district.

Students understand that they are responsible for understanding how their educational choices, including my decisions to take a MOCAP course, may impact my student's MSHSAA or NCAA eligibility.
