

# MOCAP Enrollment

First, choose the MOCAP pathway. You may either request a MOCAP course enrollment from your current school or district or transfer to a host district to enroll in a full-time MOCAP program

## MOCAP Course Enrollment

The student remains enrolled in their local school district.

The student makes a written request to their local school or district to take between one and six online courses.

The local MOCAP course enrollment policy is used to determine if the request is approved.

District approval is required and is not guaranteed.

Once approved, the local district funds the course(s), monitors student progress, manages IEP/504 plans if applicable.

## MOCAP Full-Time Hosted Enrollment

The student transfers and becomes a student of the MOCAP host district.

District approval is not required.

Enrollment is completed by the parents/guardians and is done directly with the provider.

Many providers offer an "Enroll Now" option on their website.

Provider websites are linked in the Customer Service section of each provider's page on the MOCAP website.

The host district provides funding for the courses, monitors student progress, and provides services such as IEP/504 plans if applicable.
